This month, we are going to be concentrating on two different areas of math.

We are beginning to learn about geometric shapes, including 1,2, and 3 dimensional shapes. A great way for them to practice learning about shapes at home is to build things with blocks or legos and discuss the shapes that you build.

The other area that we are introducing is multiplication. We will start out by introducing 0's, 1's, 2's, and 3's.

In second grade we only cover our table up to 10. I encourage you to review these facts with your child. Thank you.
